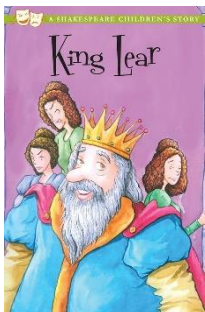




Year 5 Newsletter, Spring 2

The children will be using a range of techniques to create stuffed toys. We will be threading needles, sewing and stitching objects on to our designs using different fabrics.



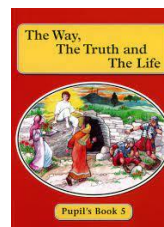
Maths

French

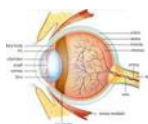
In French, the children will be continuing learning all about describing themselves and how they feel.
