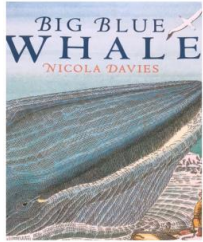




Year 3/4 Newsletter - Spring 2

DT

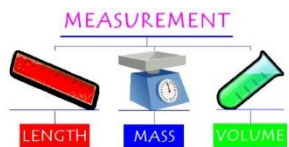
In DT we will be making our own cushions. We will learn how to stitch and add details to our cushions.

Our topic this half term is all about Mass. The children will learn about all the important parts of mass and link it to 'The Last Supper'.

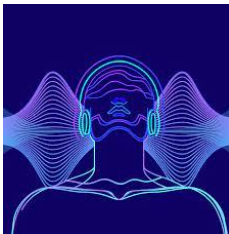


PSHE/RHE
