Attendance	There had been issues with attendance at the previous school. There was a breakdown in communication and the family withdrew the child from the school, just before year 6.		
Behaviour/Exclusion history	From the previous school, there had been a number of issues with behaviour and attendance. For the Autumn and Spring Term, the attendance was 100%. Due to a medical procedure, the attendance was 88%, as the result of attendance at hospital.		
Current provision and timetabling	Pastoral support, one to one work in class. Extra reading work and Maths club provision.

Parent views	Noted that the child really wants to be in school and talks a lot about what he is learning. Much more positive and calm. No outburst of anger and enjoys every aspect of learning.		
Comments	A vulnerable pupil, who has really benefitted from working one to one, Confidence and engagement much more evident. Transition will be challenging, as a lot of emotional support has been given, through use of pupil premium funding, which went towards funding separate lessons for the cohort in the morning. This increased significantly throughout the term.
